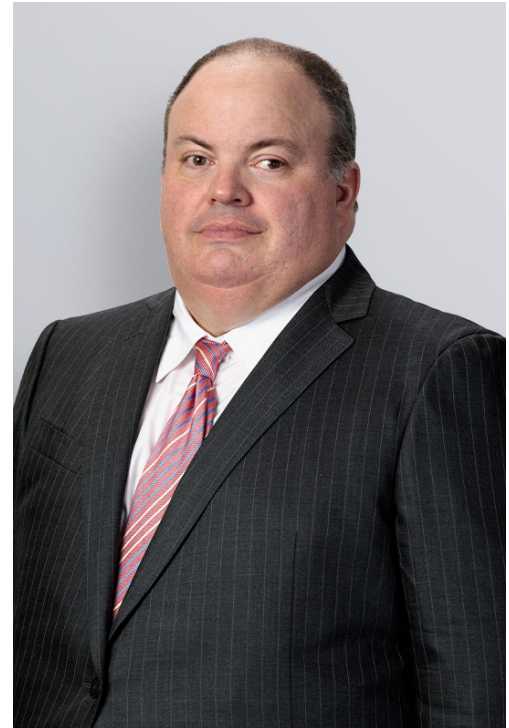

Notable Representations
