Ms. Rosenwald started her legal career as a clerk for the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit.

Ms. Rosenwald currently serves as legal advisor to Ecellix, a battery startup, and is a Venture Partner with Spike Ventures, which invests in companies founded by Stanford alumni.

Ms. Rosenwald is former Chair of the Board of Cornish College of the Arts, and current chair of the Leadership Council and Executive and Advancement Committees of the University of Washington School of Law. Ms. Rosenwald is passionate about inventions and ideas, as well as educating and mentoring young adults and new professionals. She frequently presents on intellectual property, technology access, and other topics.
